

Besides, we also offer job opportunities to individuals who do not have a sustainable job or those who've been unemployed for a long time as we are in constant need of people who can contribute their whole time taking good care of our inmates. Our entire team of staff till date has been hired from several NGOs, Rehabilitation Centres and Helping Homes for beggars, domestic violence survivors, etc.

Throughout our journey, numerous social workers, students, and working professionals from different walks of life have come forward and extended a helping hand. Some of them were with us temporarily, and others are frequent visitors without making SMIT their permanent home. Soon we're planning to not only hire a second gender staff but also provide them with education and skill development.
